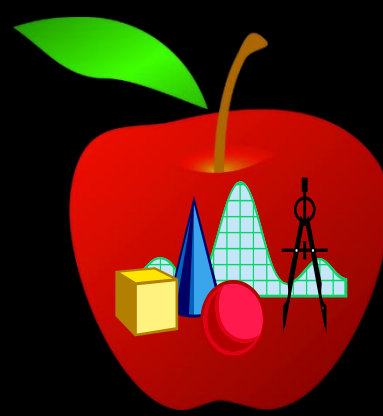

## Focus/Standards

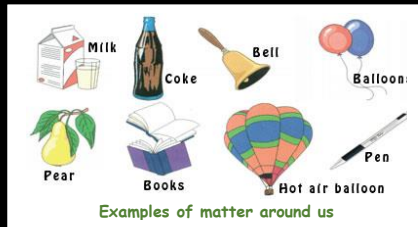
How would you describe Wally's day? Why?

Occupation: Explorer

Best known for: Matthew Henson may have been the first person to stand at the North Pole. He reached the Pole as a member of an expedition to the Arctic led by the explorer Robert E. Peary in 1909.
